Location & Campus

The School is located near Kaipattoor Junction connected by roads from Pathanamthitta, Pandalam and Adoor.

Affiliation

The School has obtained affiliation upto Std. XII from Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) Delhi, which functions under the Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India under No. 93041 SS-00000-1112/2010.

The School has obtained the statutory permission from General Education Department, Government of Kerala to run a CBSE affiliated school. No. 4634/N3/2001/Dt.16.03.2001.

Syllabus and Medium of Instruction

The school follows CBSE syllabus with the help of NCERT, CBSE publications. Medium of instruction is English. Due importance is given to Hindi, the National Language. Malayalam being the regional language is taught from pre-primary classes.

UNIFORM

All students have to wear the school uniforms on all working days. Materials of school uniform and stitching pattern are available in the school. Parents are expected to buy the same from the school to avoid diversity in shades, texture and pattern.

Transfer of Students

Leave and Absence
